

Safety

The safety on board and during excursions is a priority at every moment of our operation. That is why we are governed by the highest standards in terms of infrastructure and equipment, as well as implementing strict protocols that safeguard the safety of passengers and crew members. To ensure that all these protocols are properly complied with, we carry out periodic audits and training of our guides and crew. We deploy information systems on board to ensure that all our passengers are properly informed and understand the conduct they must adhere to.

Currency

The Chilean peso is the official currency on board the ship. American Express, Diners Club, MasterCard and Visa credit cards and U.S. dollars are also accepted.

The ship does not maintain a currency exchange.

Smoking Policy

Stella Australis has a nonsmoking policy. Smoking is permitted only on the ship's outer deck in designated areas.

Medical Services

A first aid kit is available and officers are trained in basic first aid. In case of a medical emergency, passengers will be transferred to the closest city. Participants should bring a sufficient supply of required prescription medicines as they will not be available on board.
